IV. BOARD DISCUSSION

- A. High School / Great Oaks Partnership** - Travis Hunt (High School Principal) presented the partnership program between Oak Hills and all of the Oaks (particularly Diamond Oaks). 283 students from Oak Hills attend Diamond Oaks in 20 different career programs and 40% of Diamond Oaks is made up of Oak Hills students. Mr. Hunt explained how the Oaks partner with employers to provide interactive experiences. A handout was provided.
- B. Spanish Immersion Update** - Corey Kessler (Director of Curriculum) presented the background of the immersion program which started in 2013-2014. Mr. Kessler explained the staffing needs and current student data, as well as current class sizes. Mr. Kessler provided achievement results from the most recent spring data. A handout was provided.
- C. Facilities Update** - Jason Nash (Director of Operations) recommended that the Board move forward with the following projects (P.I. Fund) for the 2024-2025 school year:
- High School
 - Add 60 parking spots - \$400k
 - Replace Football Bleachers (visitor side) - \$500k
 - Campus Wide Camera Replacement - \$186k
 - CO Harrison - begin elevator permits & drawings - \$100k
