#### A. Transportation Update

## B. Report Card Review - Elementary Administration

Oak Hills Local School District's instructional services are delivered through a Multi-Tiered System of Support (MTSS). MTSS is a preventative framework for delivering differentiated support matched to the needs of the whole child (academic, behavioral, and wellness).

The discussion provided an overview of the current status of the implementation and impact of MTSS across the district. It includes an update about the stages of implementation, internal capacity development, fidelity of implementation, and influence on student outcomes.

Goals included: improving K-3 literacy, implementing MTSS, and improving student attendance. Literacy data was reviewed and multiple handouts were provided.
