Facts about the Flu

The flu is a contagious respiratory illness caused by influenza viruses.

The Center for Disease Control recommends a yearly flu vaccine as the first and most important step in protecting against flu viruses. Cover your nose and mouth with a tissue when you cough or sneeze. Throw the tissue in the trash after you use it. [Wash your hands](#) often with soap and water. If soap and water are not available, use an alcohol-based hand rub. Avoid touching your eyes, nose and mouth. Germs spread this way. [Click here](#) for information about the Flu.

State Immunization Requirements for 2017-2018

For all 8th Grade Students

If you received an email and/or text message earlier in the week regarding your child's missing Meningococcal vaccine, please help us get the first date on your child's school records before the end of the year. If you have any questions, please call the Health Room at 922-8400 ext. 2

For all 6th Grade Students

The Ohio Department of Health requires that 7th grade students must receive the following vaccines: one dose of **Tdap** (Diphtheria, Tetanus, Pertussis) and one dose of **MCV4** (Meningococcal.) These vaccines are not new and many children receive them around 11 years of age.

Records can be completed by sending a vaccine record from your physician's office or by filling out the 7th grade immunization form. This form is found on the OH website [School](#).
